Re: Bingo Fundraiser Event Partnership with Game Night at Copper Sky

Maricopa Seniors, Inc. is pleased to present this proposal for a partnership with the City of Maricopa for Game Night at Copper Sky.

Request: To obtain City Council approval to offer Bingo as fundraising recreational gaming

four (4) times per year as a scheduled activity of Game Night at Copper Sky.

<u>License:</u> Maricopa Seniors, Inc. currently holds a Class A Bingo License, **#11-162-A**,

which we obtained in 2011. The current license would need to be modified to indicate additional game dates and times at Copper Sky. Approval from City Council would also be required to allow recreational gaming on City property.

Dates: Proposed Game Nights (last Friday of the month) in:

February

March

• September

October

<u>Times:</u> Doors open at 6:00pm; First game at 6:20pm; Games conclude by 9:00pm

Attendees: (See A.R.S. Ch. 4: R15-7-201 – General Provisions, definition of "player")

• Must be age 18 or older. (No one under age 18 admitted.)

• There must be a minimum of 10 people to hold Bingo games. If less than 10, the Bingo games would be canceled and a credit given for fees.

Costs: \$10 per person, General Admission (Cash Only Accepted)

Basic admission fee covers 1 6on/8up Bingo paper set

All transactions are Cash Only and would be handled by Maricopa Seniors.

Extras: \$1.00 each – Bingo dabbers (assorted colors)

\$7.00 each – 1 Additional 60n/8up Bingo paper set (maximum of 1 per player) \$1.00 each – Special "Double Action" Game Paper (maximum of 4 per player) All transactions are Cash Only and would be handled by Maricopa Seniors.

Games: A total of 9 games per session.

• Games 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, and 8 are standard Bingo games, each with a specific shape that must be "covered" for a Bingo. (examples: four corners, horizontal line, etc.)

- Game 5 is the "Double Action" game, and papers must be purchased separately. (Double Action has 2 numbers per square on a standard 75 *square 5 column, 5 numbers per column paper.)*
- Game 9 is a cover-all game (also referred to as "black-out"), where all squares must be covered. (At the beginning of the evening, one (1) ball is called and announced whether it is an odd or even number. Players cover all odd or even numbers on that game sheet, leaving only the remaining numbers to be covered for a Bingo.)

Jackpots:

Jackpots for all games but Game 5 are paid in cash based on total attendees, using a pre-determined formula. Jackpots are computed using a percentage split based on the total number of attendees purchasing the basic admission 6on/8up game set. Additional purchases of a 6on/8up set result in a specific cash amount going toward each jackpot. A table showing the breakdowns by attendee totals and payouts is included.

Game 5 (Double Action) is a 50/50 split jackpot based on total games sold. (Each sheet is \$1.00, and players are limited to a total of 4 sheets.)

In the event of multiple winners for a single jackpot, the jackpot is divided equally.

Fees:

Based on the established Game Night at Copper Sky event series, there is no room rental charge. However, to maintain consistency with our current Bingo agreements at The Villages HOA, the following fees are suggested for Maricopa Seniors, Inc., including allowing a credit for any date canceled / not held:

Room Rental \$8.00 per occasion \$32.00 for 4 games Table/Chair Rental \$8.75 per occasion \$35.00 for 4 games

Oversight: Maricopa Seniors, Inc. would be responsible for all aspects of the Bingo games, including set-up, execution of the games, sales of Bingo sets, dabbers, etc. No advance registration for Bingo would be required and Maricopa Seniors will handle all cash transactions. Access to Activity Room B would be limited to the main entry door located off the hallway. There would be no access from Room A.

Reporting: Maricopa Seniors will supply a written report to Community Services upon request and after the four (4) game cycle.

Payment: There would have a written agreement specifying all details of this partnership, including payments, reports to be submitted, etc. Renewal options would be

specified in the agreement as mutually agreed by the City and Maricopa Seniors.

Staffing: Maricopa Seniors, Inc. is responsible for providing all staffing for Bingo. Those

individuals listed on our License will be facilitating all Bingo games, with

additional volunteer support as needed.

Insurance: Maricopa Seniors, Inc. has General Liability Insurance and would comply to meet

minimum coverage amounts as requested and to name the City as an "also

insured" party as needed.
