Grant Overview

- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
 - Non-competitive
 - Flexible program providing resources
- State Special Projects (SSP)
 - Competitive
 - Only for low/moderate citizens
 - Shovel Ready (design and engineer complete)



Objectives of Programs

- Benefit low to moderate income persons
 - Community wide benefit
 - Limited clientele (e.g. seniors)
 - Area benefit (e.g. neighborhood must be 51%)
- Address slum and blight (Redevelopment Area)
- Address urgent need (designated disaster area)

Eligible Grant Activities

- Public Works
- Public Services
- Economic Development
- Housing
- Community Facilities
- Community Revitalization



Past Projects

- Construction of Domestic Violence Shelter
- Street Improvements
 - Fred Cole, Ed Green, and Dallas Smith
 - Justin Drive
 - Plainview

Funding

- CDBG
 - Partner with the City of Eloy
 - Receive Funds every other year
 - Historically does not exceed \$300,000
- SSP
 - Maximum allowed \$300,000

- Paving Lexington and Roosevelt
- New Saddleback Vista Arsenic Tx. System
- Street Improvements –Steen Road
- Property Acquisition in Heritage District for demolition
