City of Maricopa Annexation 10-Year Service Plan/Analysis Case # ANX22-02

I. Subject Area.

This proposal is to annex a one mile stretch of roadway by 100 feet wide that is currently under the jurisdiction of Pinal County. This request will allow the city to properly take ownership of the ADOT ROW as previously initiated by the city on October 18, 2022.



II. Level of Service to be Provided.

a. Police Protection

Police services include criminal investigations, routine patrol, traffic enforcement, and dispatched response to both emergency and non-emergency service calls. No new patrol officers or patrol units are necessary as a result of this annexation and it is anticipated that police services within the annexed area will be provided utilizing existing levels of personnel and equipment.

b. Fire Protection

The City of Maricopa Fire/Medical Department will provide all-risk/all-hazard emergency response including fire suppression, emergency medical services, and fire prevention services within the annexed area. A private ambulance provider has the authority to provide ambulance transportation within this annexed area.

c. Maintenance of Roads, Streets, and Street Lights

The City will assume the responsibility for maintenance of road segment as shown in the subject area map and will be maintained in a condition which is at least equal to the City maintenance standard. The City will be responsible for improving the roadway to city minimum standards within the next 3-4 years and then ongoing schedule maintenance after that, contingent on funding being available, see table below. Currently the road does not have any streets lights. Any private developments along the road segment will be required to install any required street lights as determined by the City Engineer.

2026	Reconstruct and widen roadway to a 4-lane facility with raised median	\$5,000,000
2029	Preservative seal/ pavement markings/ traffic control	\$100,000
2033	Crack seal/ preservative seal/ pavement markings/traffic control	\$200,000

d. Other Municipal Service.

All other City Departments with jurisdiction in the area will provide services according to City policy and procedure.

This plan should assist the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa to make informed decisions on how to proceed with the proposed annexation.
