

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-34**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE AK CHIN INDIAN COMMUNITY FOR THE BOYS & GIRLS CLUB OF THE SUN CORRIDOR AND AGREEING TO ACT AS THE DESIGNATED FISCAL AGENT OF SUCH FUNDING.**

**WHEREAS**, the Ak Chin Indian Community disburses grant money to non-profit agencies within a broad spectrum of services and programs that serve the general public; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to be eligible to receive funding from the Ak Chin Indian Community, a local non-profit must show that the City of Maricopa will act as a fiscal agent and accept funding on behalf on the non-profit 's behalf; and

**WHEREAS**, the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sun Corridor is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization that supports academic success, good character and citizenship and healthy lifestyles; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council believe it would be beneficial for the citizens of the City of Maricopa and Pinal County to support the grant application of The Boys & Girls Club of the Sun Corridor.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY**, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, that the City of Maricopa, Arizona supports the submission of a grant application to the Ak Chin Indian Community for funding the Boys & Girls Club of the Sun Corridor and agrees to act as the designated fiscal agent for such funding.
