TAC members roles under the 5311 grant

• The Transit Advisory Commission (TAC) is a requirement of the Arizona State plan to administer the Federal Transit Administration funds under the 5311 grant. In compliance with the ADOT requirements, Resolution 23-20 of the Maricopa City Council appointed the members of the Planning and Zoning commission to serve as the Transit Advisory Committee.



ADOT's 5311 guidebooks role of the TAC

- TAC's role is to advise the grantee agency on the operation of the system.
 - local needs
 - commenting on service quality and effectiveness
 - soliciting community participation
 - helping the system achieve financial sustainability
 - and related issues
- TAC members should be ambassadors for the transit program and serve as the Transit Manager's eyes and ears in the community.



City Council resolution describes the role of the TAC:

• Transit Advisory Committee is required to meet quarterly provide guidance, recommend policies, and receive and discuss public input regarding the City's transit services



TAC requirement ending

- At the conclusion of the Cities 5311 grant funding on 9-30-2024 the requirement for the Transit Advisory Committee will end.
- TAC will be required to meet one additional time prior to the conclusion of the grant.
