

RESOLUTION NO. 16-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE AK-CHIN INDIAN COMMUNITY FOR FUNDING KEEPING TEACHERS TEACHING AND AGREEING TO ACT AS THE DESIGNATED FISCAL AGENT OF SUCH FUNDING.

WHEREAS, The Ak-Chin Indian Community disburses grant money to non-profit agencies within a broad spectrum of services and programs that serve the general public; and

WHEREAS, in order to be eligible to receive funding from the Ak-Chin Indian Community, a local non-profit must show that the City of Maricopa will act as a fiscal agent and accept funding on behalf on the non-profit's behalf; and

WHEREAS, Keeping Teachers Teaching is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization that supports a high quality education by focusing on the well-being of the teachers molding the minds of children; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council believe it would be beneficial for the citizens of the City of Maricopa and Pinal County to support the grant application of Keeping Teachers Teaching.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, that the City of Maricopa, Arizona supports the submission of a grant application to the Ak-Chin Indian Community for funding Keeping Teachers Teaching and agrees to act as the designated fiscal agent for such funding.
