3. Call to the Public

There was no public comments.

4. Minutes

4.1 Approval of Minutes from the November 13, 2023 Planning and Zoning Commission meeting.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hughes, seconded by Commissioner Juarez III, that this Minutes be Approved. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

5. Regular Agenda

5.1 PPE 23-01

SUBDIVISION PPE23-01: The Planning and Zoning Commission shall discuss and possibly take action on approving a one (1) time two (2) year extension of Preliminary Plat approval case # SUB21-20, Red Valley Ranch Preliminary Plat. DISCUSSION AND ACTION

Richard Williams, Planning and Zoning Manager, presented the details of item 5.1. No members of the Planning and Zoning Commission had questions or concerns on the item.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hughes, seconded by Commissioner Robertson, that this Subdivision be Approved. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

5.2 TXT 23-04

PUBLIC HEARING: TXT23-04 Text Amendment: A request by the City of Maricopa for review and approval of a proposed text amendment to Section 17, Subdivision Regulations, and Section 18, Maricopa Zoning Ordinance, as contained in Exhibit A.1 and B.1; DISCUSSION AND ACTION.

Richard Williams, Planning and Zoning Manager, presented the details of item 5.2. Vice-Chair Robertson pointed out that the text amendment did not include a section on a Housing Impact Statement. Nick Cook clarified that the City Council will receive a required Housing Impact Statement for this amendment.

Commissioner Juarez inquired on the exclusion of in-laws in the section on nepotism. Richard Williams clarified that it is consistent with existing language in the Code. Juarez inquired on whether or not the inclusion of in-laws is appropriate and clarified that he wishes to understand the intent on the exclusion. Richard Williams stated that the City may take a look at the exclusion of in-laws separately, but at the moment the City wishes to remain consistent with other sections of the City Ordinance. Further discussion briefly followed.

The Public Hearing was opened at 6:49 p.m. There were no public comments. The hearing was closed at 6:49 p.m.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hughes, seconded by Commissioner Singleton, that this Text Amendment be Approved. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.
