



PURCHASING SUMMARY

Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Station Operation RFP 15CM122314

In accordance with City of Maricopa, Purchasing Code, Article IV, Sec 3-215, the City issued a solicitation detailing requirements for the operation of a recycling and HHW drop-off station.

Adequate public notice was given by placing the Request for Proposal (RFP) on the City's web site, www.maricopa-az.gov, on December 30, 2014. In compliance with A.R.S. § 34-201 (A), an advertisement was placed in the Casa Grande Dispatch on January 4, 2015 and January 11, 2015; in the Maricopa Monitor on January 6, 2015; the Eloy Enterprise on January 8, 2015; and the Florence Reminder & Blade-Tribune on January 8, 2015.

An Amendment was issued for this project on January 7, 2015, to clarify and expand on the Pricing Sheet. The Request for Proposal closed on January 20, 2015. The submitted proposals were publicly opened at the time and place designated within the RFP at the City Hall.

Three (3) proposals were received. The preliminary review conducted by the Purchasing Office of the proposals revealed one (1) proposal was non-responsive. The remaining two (2) proposals were delivered to the evaluation team. Based on the pre-determined evaluation criteria, the proposals rank as follows:

Vendor	Score	Rank
Right Away Disposal	86.3	1
ECO	79.0	2

Based on this scoring, it is recommended that WASTE TECHNOLOGIES, LLD dba RIGHT AWAY DISPOSAL be awarded the contract for the Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Station Operation.
