

**RESOLUTION NO. 13-02**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, DECLARING AS A PUBLIC RECORD THAT CERTAIN DOCUMENT FILED WITH THE CITY CLERK AND ENTITLED “ARTICLE V - HOME DETENTION AND CONTINUOUS ALCOHOL MONITORING PROGRAM” OF THE MARICOPA CITY CODE, RELATING TO THE ENACTMENT OF A PROGRAM TO ALLOW THE COURT TO SUBSTITUTE HOME DETENTION OR CONTINUOUS ALCOHOL MONITORING FOR A PORTION OF A JAIL TERM AND AMENDING THE MARICOPA CITY CODE BY INSERTING ARTICLE V IN CHAPTER 5 OF THE CITY CODE.**

**WHEREAS**, staff for the City has provided some guidelines for the creation of a home detention and continuous alcohol monitoring program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council believes that declaring such document a public record and adopting its provisions by reference will be in the City’s best interests;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona as follows:

That certain document known as “Article V - Home Detention and Continuous Alcohol Monitoring Program” amending the Maricopa City Code by adding Article V to Chapter 5 of the previously adopted City Code relating to the creation of a home detention and continuous alcohol monitoring program for the City of Maricopa, is hereby declared to be a public record, and three (3) copies shall remain on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Maricopa for examination by the public.
