8.1 PH 12-007

The Mayor and City Council shall hear public comment regarding Conditional Use Permit (CUP) 12-01, a request by the City of Maricopa for review and approval of a proposed Public Dog Park.

#### 9. Consent Agenda

A Resolution of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona authorizing the submission of a grant application to the Gila River Indian Community in support of funding Environmental Concerns Inc. to provide environmental sustainability and recycling projects in the City of Maricopa and act as the designated fiscal agent. A Resolution of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona naming the City Complex Loop Roadway which will facilitate access to the new City Hall and Police Station. Discussion and Action.

#### 10.8 PUR 12-021

The Mayor and City Council shall discuss and possibly take action on approving a purchase of two MCC 7500 dispatch consoles from Creative Communications in an amount not to exceed \$38,749 and the technology component related to the purchasing of the two consoles from Motorola Solutions, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$113,940. Staff is requesting Council consider a transfer of \$152,689 from General Fund, Contingency (10010000-99000) to Police Support, Computer Equipment/Software (10022124-67744) to cover the costs for these two dispatch consoles and associated technology components. Discussion and Action.

#### 10.9 **PUR 12-022**

The Mayor and City Council shall discuss and possibly take action on approving the purchase of 20-21 ruggedized laptops mobile data terminals (Panasonic Toughbooks) from CDW-G for the City of Maricopa's Police Department in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.
