However, members of the Council shall not discuss or take legal action on any matters during an open call to the public unless the matters are properly noticed for discussion and legal action.

9.1 PUR 16-01

The Mayor and City Council shall discuss and possibly take action on approving a purchase of Spillman Computer Aided Dispatch licensing for the Copper Sky Police Substation Communications Center in an amount not to exceed \$63,778 and the transfer of \$63,778 from the City's Contingency fund (10010000-99000). Discussion and Action.

9.2 CON 16-06

The Mayor and City Council shall discuss and possibly take action to amend the Professional Services Contract with AllStaff for CIP Project Management hourly services to increase the hourly rate to \$65.00 and to increase the not to exceed amount by \$40,000, for a total amount not to exceed \$124,000.
