

RESOLUTION NO. 12-73

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING STAFF TO COMPLETE ALL NECESSARY PAPERWORK TO APPLY FOR RURAL PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM (SECTION 5311) FROM THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CONTINUE TO OPERATE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICE.

WHEREAS, Arizona Department of Transportation has a Section 5311 Rural Public Transportation program that provides funding for capital, administrative and operating assistance for public transportation programs in rural and small urban areas;

WHEREAS, funding for the 5311 program would coincide with the contract for the City of Maricopa Demand Response service; and

WHEREAS, continuing transportation system that is equipped to handle the traffic demands of the growing population in the City of Maricopa is necessary to assure the high quality of life;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona directs the City staff is hereby authorized to apply for Section 5311 funding to continue with demand response service for the City of Maricopa including, but limited to, applying for grants, proposing city budget amendments to the City Council and organization of the transit service in compliance with all state and federal requirements.
