

RESOLUTION NO. 15-37

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE AK-CHIN INDIAN COMMUNITY FOR FUNDING MARICOPA AK-CHIN CAASA FOR A YOUTH MENTORSHIP PROGRAM AND AGREEING TO ACT AS THE DESIGNATED FISCAL AGENT FOR SUCH FINDING.

WHEREAS, the Ak-Chin Indian Community disburses grant money to non-profit agencies within a broad spectrum of services and programs that serve the general public; and

WHEREAS, in order to submit an application for funding to the Ak-Chin Indian Community, a local non-profit must show that the City of Maricopa will act as a fiscal agent and accept funding on behalf on the non-profit's behalf; and

WHEREAS, Maricopa Ak-Chin CAASA is a non-profit organization that provides youth mentorship programs to prevent substance abuse and increase grades; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council believe it would be beneficial for the citizens of the City of Maricopa and Pinal County to support the grant application of Maricopa Ak-Chin CAASA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, that the City of Maricopa, Arizona supports the submission of a grant application to the Ak-Chin Indian Community for funding Maricopa Ak-Chin CAASA and agrees to act as the designated fiscal agent for such funding.
