Background


2009

- Reformatting neighborhood meetings








Redevelopment Area Plan District Overlay Excludes undeveloped areas of the City to encourage development

2009 - 2020 Heritage District Area Boundary



- The Redevelopment Area (RDA) Plan was approx. 3.1 sq. mi. and included 1000 + acres of undeveloped/vacant land
- The newly adopted RDA is compromised of the developed residential neighborhoods within the original plan.

• March 2019 – More than 15 Tons of Trash/Debris was collected












Demolitions Aerial Comparision for Maricopa Station Area






Heritage District Fencing

- The Plainview fence is still under construction but is expected to be completed by early next year.


















Solar Streetlight Project CDBG Funded Project

- Community Development Grant (CDBG) Funded Project
- Awarded \$182,000
