

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
PINAL COUNTY
AND
CITY OF MARICOPA
FOR
DETENTION OF MUNICIPAL-CHARGED INMATES**

This First Amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement ("First Amendment") is entered into this ____ day of _____, 2024 by and between Pinal County, a political subdivision of the State of Arizona, by and through the Pinal County Sheriff's Office Adult Detention Facility ("PSCO") and the City of Maricopa, an Arizona corporation ("CITY") for the detention of adult inmates arrested, held, booked and/or convicted under the authority of CITY. PSCO and CITY may also be referred to hereinafter as "Party" individually and as "Parties" collectively.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement on June 15, 2021 related to detention facilities and services being provided to CITY by PSCO (the "IGA"); and

WHEREAS, the Parties would like to amend that IGA to extend the term of the IGA.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and obligation set forth herein, the Parties agree to amend the IGA as follows:

1. Pursuant to Paragraph 3(C) of the IGA, PCSO and CITY agree to renew the IGA for an additional three (3) years. The IGA shall remain in effect until June 14, 2027.
2. Paragraph 10(A) shall be revised to the following for notice to the City:

3. All other terms and conditions of the IGA shall continue in full force and effect as set forth therein.
