

RESOLUTION NO. 14-46

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA APPROVING AND ADOPTING WIRELESS COMMUNICATION FACILITIES DESIGN STANDARDS.

WHEREAS, on October 30, 2012, City Council approved Ordinance 12-11 which adopted Article 36 of the City Zoning Code related to Wireless Telecommunications Facilities and included the Wireless Communication Facilities Design Standards; and

WHEREAS, Article 36 was repealed and replaced with the rules and regulations related to wireless communication facilities contained in the Zoning Code adopted by Ordinance 14-12; and

WHEREAS, while reviewing the proposed zoning code, the Zoning Code Rewrite Task Force and the Planning and Zoning Commission recommended that the City readopt the Wireless Communication Facilities Design Standards as a separate instrument; and

WHEREAS, such Wireless Communication Facilities Design Standards will provide direction to City staff and wireless communication providers related to the design and appearance of wireless communication facilities located within the City of Maricopa; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that approving and adopting the Wireless Communication Facilities Design Standards to promote the appealing design of wireless communication facilities located within the City will be in the City's best interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona hereby approves and adopts the Wireless Communication Facilities Design Standards in the form attached to and made a part of this Resolution.

A copy of these Wireless Communication Facilities Design Standards shall be kept on file with the City Clerk and kept available for public use and inspection.
