## **RESOLUTION NO. 24-01**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO A MUTUAL AID COMPACT WITH THE SIGNATORY POLITICAL JURISDICTIONS WITHIN THE STATE OF ARIZONA AND THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY AND MILITARY AFFAIRS.

**WHEREAS,** one or more parties to the Arizona Mutual Aid Compact ("Parties") may find it necessary to utilize all of their own resources to cope with emergencies and may require the assistance of another party or other parties; and

**WHEREAS**, it is desirable that all resources of the Parties be available to all other Parties on preestablished terms, in order to respond to such emergencies; and

**WHEREAS**, it is desirable that each of the Parties should assist one another when such emergency occurs by providing such resources as are available and needed including, but not limited to, fire, police, medical and health, environmental, communication, and transportation services to cope with the problems of response; and

**WHEREAS**, it is desirable that a compact be executed for the interchange of such mutual aid and to utilize in exercising adopted emergency plans; and

**WHEREAS,** it is desirable that the manner of financing of such cooperative undertakings be resolved in advance of such emergency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY** the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, that the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute, on behalf of the City of Maricopa, the Arizona Mutual Aid Compact, with the signatory political jurisdictions within the State of Arizona and the Arizona Department of Emergency and Military Affairs in the form attached to and made a part of this Resolution.
