

RESOLUTION NO. 12-62

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA NAMING THE RECREATIONAL COMPLEX COLLECTOR ROADWAY WHICH WILL FACILITATE ACCESS TO THE NEW MULTIGENERATIONAL CENTER AND REGIONAL PARK.

WHEREAS, the development of the new Recreational Complex involves the design and construction of a new roadway that will facilitate access to the new Multigenerational Center and Regional Park; and

WHEREAS, this Multigenerational Center and Regional Park will be created to enhance the lives of all members of the City of Maricopa community; and

WHEREAS, nearly 900 cities and towns across the United States have chosen to name various public roadways in honor of the late Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. to commemorate his humble and bold leadership in strife for equality for all; and

WHEREAS, staff has provided a recommendation to the Mayor and City Council that describes the historical and cultural significance of the naming of this roadway for the purpose of honoring Dr. King.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, that the name for the Recreational Complex collector roadway, which will facilitate access to the new Multigenerational Center and Regional Park, shall be Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard.
