## **RESOLUTION NO. 19-56**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA SUPPORTING MARICOPA WELLS MIDDLE SCHOOL AND AGREEING TO ACT AS THE DESIGNATED FISCAL AGENT FOR SUCH FUNDING FOR THE GRANT APPLICATION TO THE AK CHIN INDIAN COMMUNITY FOR FUNDING MARICOPA WELLS MIDDLE SCHOOL PROGRAM TO PURCHASE IT EQUIPMENT.

**WHEREAS**, the Ak Chin Indian Community disburses grant money to non- profit agencies within a broad spectrum of services and programs that serve the general public; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to be eligible to receive funding from the Ak Chin Indian Community, a local public school must show that the City of Maricopa will act as a fiscal agent and accept funding on the middle school's behalf; and

**WHEREAS,** Maricopa Wells Middle School is a public school that provides education for grades  $6^{th} - 8^{th}$  within the Maricopa Unified School District in Maricopa, Arizona; and

**WHEREAS,** the Mayor and City Council believe it would be beneficial for the citizens of the City of Maricopa and Pinal County to support the grant application of Maricopa Wells Middle School.

**NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY** the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, that the City of Maricopa, Arizona supports the submission of a grant application to the Ak Chin Indian Community for funding Maricopa Wells Middle School to purchase 10 laptop carts with each cart holding 36 laptops. These carts will be used by all students at Maricopa Wells Middle School for the current district wide curriculum and mandated state assessments.
