RESOLUTION NO. 18-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE AK CHIN INDIAN COMMUNITY FOR FUNDING MARICOPA HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL BOOSTER PROGRAM TO PROVIDE CAMP FEES, TRAVEL, MEALS, WORKOUT CLOTHING, UNIFORMS, EQUIPMENT, BANQUETS, AND CONCESSION STAND ITEMS AND AGREEING TO ACT AS THE DESIGNATED FISCAL AGENT FOR SUCH FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the Ak Chin Indian Community disburses grant money to non- profit agencies within a broad spectrum of services and programs that serve the general public; and

WHEREAS, in order to be eligible to receive funding from the Ak Chin Indian Community, a local non-profit must show that the City of Maricopa will act as a fiscal agent and accept funding on the non-profit's behalf; and

WHEREAS, Maricopa High School Football Booster Program is a non-profit organization that supports the Maricopa High School Football Program by providing long term life skills for its players; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council believe it would be beneficial for the citizens of the City of Maricopa and Pinal County to support the grant application of Maricopa High School Football Booster Program.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, that the City of Maricopa, Arizona supports the submission of a grant application to the Ak Chin Indian Community for funding the Maricopa High School Football Booster Program to provide football camp fees and related travel expenses, meals, workout clothing, uniforms, equipment, banquets and concession stand items and agrees to act as the designated fiscal agent for such funding.
