It was good to talk with you. You can find information on the Local Visitor Information Center (LVIC) program at http://www.azot.gov/marketing-programs/visitor-services. We also have other resources related to tourism marketing and product development located on the website.

Regarding your questions about compliance: the center is able to be open 40 hours M-F and remain compliant, and not having a dedicated phone for visitors will not affect your compliance.

The LVIC program was developed to give visitors to Arizona a consistent service at local visitor centers. When visitors see blue "Tourist Information" signs on the highway they can expect to find information on the local community as well as attractions throughout the state. The Arizona Office of Tourism works in cooperation with the Arizona Department of Transportation to sign designated visitor centers. AOT also supplies maps and guides, as well as educational opportunities for visitor center staff.
