Purchase of LifePak 15 Defibrillators for Fire Department
NASPO Contract # SW300

In accordance with City of Maricopa, Purchasing Code, Article IV, Section 3-223, Cooperative Purchasing, it is recommended that the NASPO (National Association of State Procurement Officials) contract # SW300 be utilized to purchase new LifePak 15 Defibrillators for the Maricopa Fire Department.

The NASPO contract was competitively bid in 2010 and was awarded on April 1, 2011 to multiple firms. This contract term is for one (1) year with five (5) one (1) year renewal options. The current option term expires on March 31, 2015. NASPO is a non-profit association dedicated to strengthening the procurement community through education, research, and communication. It is made up of the directors of the central purchasing offices in each of the 50 states, the District of Columbia and the territories of the United States. The contract documents were reviewed by the City of Maricopa Purchasing staff and it meets the City Purchasing Code. This contract is with Physio-Control, Inc. the current provider for the calibration, service, and support of our existing units.

Based upon the specification review done by the City of Maricopa Staff, and utilizing the favorable pricing obtained by using the NASPO cooperative contract, it is recommended that the new LifePak 15 Defibrillators be purchased from Physio-Control, Inc.
