### 8. Public Hearings

8.1 PH 13-01

The Mayor and City Council shall hold a public hearing as required by A.R.S. §9-471 (L) for Case #ZON12-03, a proposed change in zoning classification from County to Municipal Zoning for all properties within the recently completed Annexation 11-01, as approved by the City Council with Ordinance 12-06.

#### 9. Consent Agenda

9.1 GRA 13-01
