# What is the ERRP

- This plan describes the methods the City will use to mobilize resources and conduct emergency response and recovery activities.
- Predetermines, to the extent possible, operational policies and responsibilities of City departments, cooperating government, private and volunteer agencies for responding to and recovering from large scale emergencies.

# Composition of Plan

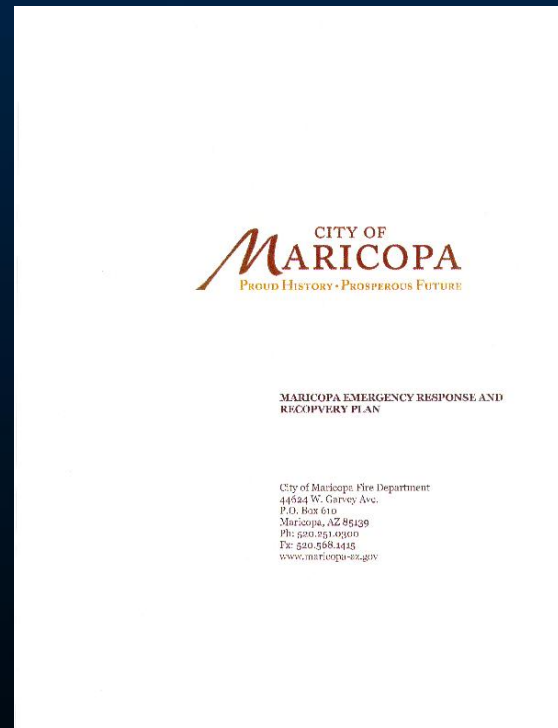
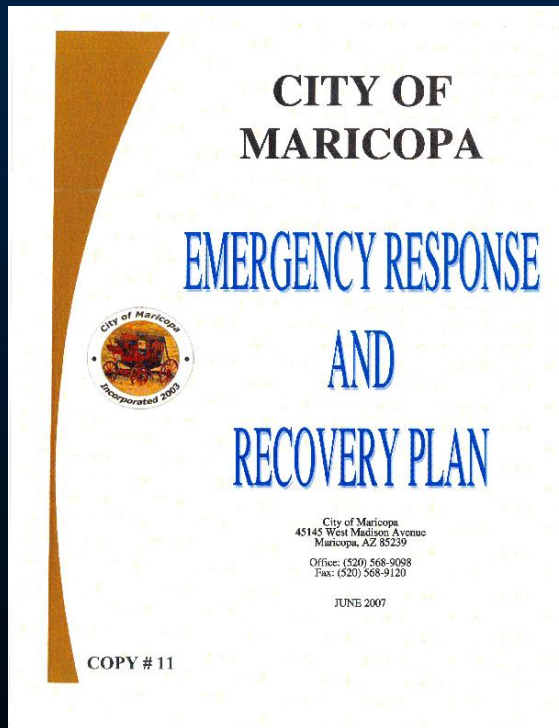
<b>Basic Plan</b>	<b>A base plan that describes the structure and concept of operation.</b>
<b>Emergency Support Functions (ESF) Annexes</b>	<b>Details the missions, policies and responsibilities of departments and agencies during incidents.</b>
<b>Incident Annexes</b>	<b>Address contingency or hazard situations requiring specialized application. (Terrorism, pandemic events, etc.)</b>
<b>Support Annexes</b>	<b>Reference and support documents; glossary of terms, mutual aid agreements, authorities, SOPs.</b>

# Background

- The City of Maricopa ERRP was created and adopted in 2007 and has not been revised since.
- Revisions reflect changes due to operational needs.
- Responsive to changing conditions.

- To re-brand the document



# Purpose

- Reduce size
  - Reformatting, removing bulk reference material and rebranding reduced nearly 300 pages.
- Responds to changes in organizational structure
  - Aligns with City departments.

# Purpose

- Improve Security
  - Removes large distribution list
    - 58 public, private & volunteer agencies and organizations
  - Remove sensitive information
    - Location of EOC
    - Access codes to EOC
    - Phone lists

# Purpose

- The amended ERRP will replace previous versions and allow for regular and routine updates.
