

RESOLUTION NO. 25-39

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, PINAL COUNTY, ARIZONA, CONFIRMING THE APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF NECESSITY SUBSEQUENT TO CHANGES NECESSITATED BY SUBSTANTIVE REVIEW BY THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City, through its Fire/Medical Department, submitted an Application for Certificate of Necessity for Ground Ambulance Services (“Application”) on or about February 19, 2025; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Application, the Arizona Department of Health Services Bureau of Emergency Medical Services & Trauma Systems (“Bureau”) reviews it for administrative and substantive review under the applicable statutes and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Application has now passed through the Bureau administrative and substantive reviews and requested changes were made to the Application, including the submitted ambulance revenue and cost report.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council and City Manager have reviewed the revisions to the Application necessitated by administrative and substantive review by the Bureau.

Section 2. That the City Council and City Manager understand the changes to the Application and continue to support the provision of ground ambulance transport services by the City.

Section 3. That the City Council and City Manager understand that the ground ambulance transport services may operate at a financial loss and agree to support the provision of ground ambulance transport services even if operated at financial loss as demonstrated by the Application and ambulance revenue and cost report.
