

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 12-10**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, ADOPTING "CHAPTER 12 TRAFFIC AND PARKING" BY REFERENCE AS SECTIONS 12-1 THROUGH 12-64 OF THE MARICOPA CITY CODE AND REPEALING ARTICLES I THROUGH IV OF CHAPTER 12 OF THE MARICOPA CITY CODE AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.**

**WHEREAS**, that certain document known as the "Chapter 12 Traffic and Parking" was adopted as a public record by Resolution No. 12-74 on October 16, 2012;

**WHEREAS**, on June 1, 2004, the City of Maricopa adopted Chapter 12 Traffic and Parking as part of the City Code, which was amended on September 21, 2010;

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa believe, after consultation with its staff, that amending Chapter 12 by repealing Articles I through IV and adopting Sections 12-1 through 12-64 would be in the best interest of the City of Maricopa; and

**WHEREAS**, A.R.S. §9-802 allows a City to adopt a public record by Ordinance as a means to reduce publication costs while ensuring that the public gets fair notice and opportunity to review its operative provisions;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 9-802, that certain document known as "CHAPTER 12 TRAFFIC AND PARKING" of the Maricopa City Code, three copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, which document was made a public record by Resolution No. 12-74 of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this Ordinance.

**SECTION 2.** Chapter 12 of the Maricopa City Code and all amendments thereto are hereby repealed in their entirety and replaced with Chapter 12 Traffic and Parking which was made public record by Resolution No. 12-74 of the City of Maricopa, Arizona.

**SECTION 3.** The following violations of any rules or regulations of the City of Maricopa related to traffic control devices or barricades shall carry the following fines:

<b>VIOLATION</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	<b>CIVIL SANCTION</b>
#1	Creates imminent risk of injury to the public within Right-of-Way.	\$1,500
#2	Restricting Right-of-Way without the proper permit.	\$1,000
#3	Restricting traffic during peak hours as described in the Traffic Barricade Manual without authorization.	\$1,000
#4	Failing to correct a violation, as listed, within the time period stated on the warning notice.	\$1,000
#5	Restricting traffic at signal with no work occurring.	\$1,000
#6	Closing sidewalk improperly or without a permit.	\$500
#7	Violating the restrictions, limits, times, and locations of the permit.	\$500
#8	Missing or improper use of advance warning signs.	\$500
#9	Missing or improper barricades/channelizing devices.	\$500
#10	Leaving advance warning signs facing traffic after restriction has been removed – per one traffic direction	\$250
#11	Leaving Temporary Traffic Control devices in the Right-of-Way 24-hours after permit expires, unless a request for a permit extension is received prior to the expiration of permit.	\$250
#12	Use of “ <b>unacceptable</b> ” quality traffic control devices as described in the Traffic Barricade Manual.	\$250
#13	Rendering a bus stop inaccessible without relocating it or making other accommodations.	\$250

- Repetitive sanctions: Each calendar day may be considered a separate violation.

**SECTION 4.** The following violations of any rules or regulations of the City of Maricopa related stopping, standing or parking shall carry the following fines:

MCC-12-53(o)	Railroad Crossings, Tracks (within 50 feet of crossing)	\$57
MCC-12-53(p)	Double Parked	\$57
MCC-12-53(q)	Upon a Sidewalk or Forcing Pedestrian to Use Roadway	\$57
MCC-12-53(r)	Upon a Bridge or Elevated Structure	\$57
MCC-12-53(s)	Impeding Traffic Flow Near Street Excavation/Obstruction	\$57
MCC-12-53(t)	No Current Registration When Parking on Public Property	\$57
MCC-12-53(u)	Parallel Parking; 18 inches from curb	\$57
MCC-12-53(v)	In Front of Postal Box	\$57
MCC-12-54	Over Parking (72 Hours)	\$57
MCC-12-58	Curb Loading Zone	\$57
MCC-12-59	Oversized Vehicle	\$120
MCC-12-60	Physically Disabled Zone	\$276

The amount due includes the penalty fee and all State mandated surcharges (84%). If more than one violation is listed, the violator must pay the appropriate amount for each. If paid within 30 days of the violation, subtract \$20 from each violation

**SECTION 5.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

**SECTION 6.** This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of adoption by the City Council for the City of Maricopa.
