- Follows a function-focused format composed of:
  - Base Plan
  - Functional Annexes
  - Threat- or Hazard-specific Annexes
- Meets requirements to maintain eligibility for emergency management funding opportunities.
- Focused on what's best for Maricopa; the plan was designed to allow for flexibility as our city grows.



# After adoption, what is next?

- Distribution of the plan is documented to establish a record and maintain its integrity.
- The plan will be reviewed and revised based on:
  - Updates to laws, policies, standards.
  - Lessons learned from exercises, drills, and response to incidents.
  - Hazard analysis.
  - Current capabilities.
