The Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) is a comprehensive guide for the city's approach to effectively managing a wide range of emergencies, including those stemming from natural disasters, technological incidents, and human-caused incidents.

Purpose

- To build community durability and preparedness for all hazards.

Update Necessary

- Current plan was adopted in 2012.



Details about the updated plan.

- Follows a function-focused format composed of:
 - Base Plan
 - Functional Annexes
 - Threat- or Hazard-specific Annexes
- Meets requirements to maintain eligibility for emergency management funding opportunities.
- Focused on what's best for Maricopa; the plan was designed to allow for flexibility as our city grows.

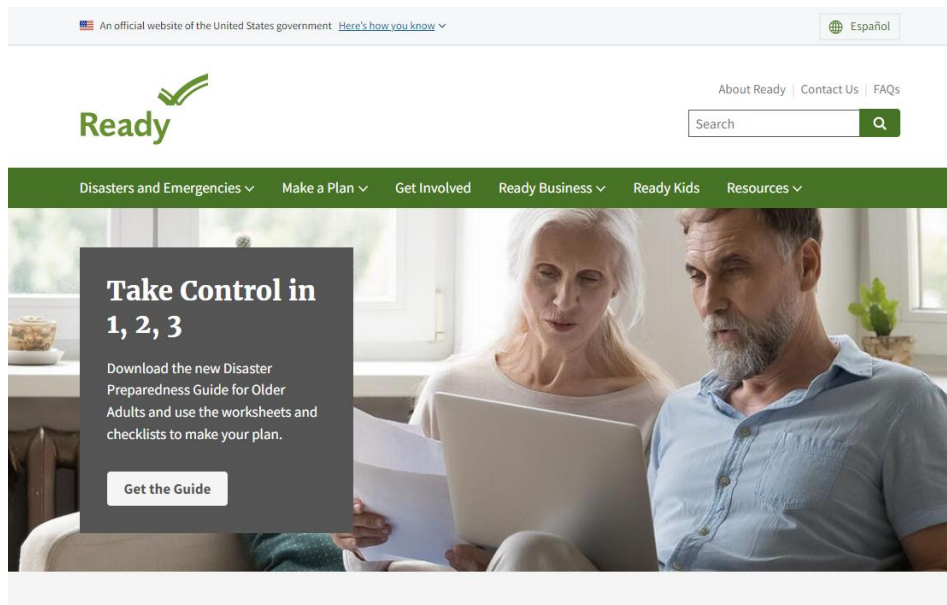


After adoption, what is next?
