

ORDINANCE NO. 14-15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, AMENDING SECTION 2-82(1)(a)(i) OF THE MARICOPA CITY CODE TO ADD THE NON-PROFIT FUNDING EVALUATION COMMITTEE AS A STANDING COMMITTEE AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2012, the Mayor and City Council approved Ordinance 12-07 adopting Section 2-82 of the Maricopa City Code entitled Boards Committees and Commission; and

WHEREAS, on October 7, 2014, the Mayor and City Council approved Resolution 14-43 adopting revisions to the Maricopa's Non-Profit Funding Program which included the creation of an evaluation committee; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Section 2-82 of the Maricopa City Code to include the Non-Profit Funding Evaluation Committee as a Council Established Committee.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona:

SECTION 1. Section 2-82(1)(a)(i) of the City Code of Maricopa is hereby amended to add the Non-Profit Funding Evaluation Committee as a Council Established Standing Committee.

SECTION 2. To the extent of any conflict between other City Ordinances and this Ordinance, this Ordinance shall be deemed to be controlling; provided, however, that this Ordinance is not intended to amend or repeal any existing City Ordinance, Resolution or regulation except as expressly set forth herein.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of adoption by the City Council for the City of Maricopa.
