RESOLUTION NO. 25-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, ADOPTING A BED TAX POLICY RELATED TO THE ALLOCATION AND EXPENDITURE OF THE HOTEL/MOTEL ADDITIONAL TAX REVENUE IN COMPLIANCE WITH A.R.S. §9-500.06 AND PURSUANT TO THE STRATEGIC PRIORITIES OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, A.R.S. §9-500.06 requires a portion of the hotel/motel additional tax revenue be used to promote tourism; and

WHEREAS, City Council adopted Strategic Priorities for the City which included investing in public art projects and experiences and employing a sports and event tourism strategy that encompasses broad appeal; and

WHEREAS, through the budget process the City Council previously approved the use of a portion of the hotel/motel additional tax for art initiatives; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with A.R.S. §9-500.06 and the City's Strategic Priorities, the City Council of the City of Maricopa believes adopting a policy related to the allocation and expenditure of the hotel/motel additional tax revenue is in the best interest of the City of Maricopa.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona that the Maricopa City Council hereby adopts the Bed Tax Policy related to the allocation and expenditure of the hotel/motel additional tax revenue in compliance with A.R.S. §9-500.06 and pursuant to the Strategic Priorities of the City, in the form attached to and made a part of this Resolution.
