

RESOLUTION NO. 26-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, PINAL COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS, AS PROVIDED BY PINAL COUNTY, OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION HELD ON JULY 21, 2026.

WHEREAS, the City of Maricopa, Pinal County, Arizona did hold a primary election on the 21st day of July, 2026 for the election of three Councilmembers for a 4-year term; and

WHEREAS, on January 16, 2024, the City entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Pinal County for election services, for the 2024 and 2026 elections, which required Pinal County to tally official results of the election; and

WHEREAS, Pinal County has presented the election returns to the City Council, as provided in Exhibit A, and these returns have been canvassed by the City Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Pinal County, Arizona, based on the returns provided by Pinal County as set forth in Exhibit A, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the total number of ballots cast at said primary election, as shown by the poll lists, was 9,153.

SECTION 2. That the number of ballots rejected was 547.

SECTION 3. That the votes cast for the candidates for councilmember were as follows:

That it is hereby found, determined and declared of record, that the following four (4) candidates did receive the next greatest number of votes of the electors of the city voting at said election and shall have their names placed on the general municipal election ballot of the City of Maricopa, Pinal County, Arizona, to be held on the 3rd day of November, 2026, and are hereby issued certificates of nomination.
