## FIRST AMENDMENT TO PRESIDING JUDGE AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO PRESIDING JUDGE AGREEMENT ("First Amendment") is made and entered into this  $2^{nd}$  day of December 2025, by and between the City of Maricopa, an Arizona municipal corporation ("City") and Steve McCarville ("McCarville"). City and McCarville are individually referred to herein as "Party" and collectively as "Parties."

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2023, the City and McCarville entered into an agreement for McCarville to serve as the Presiding Judge of the City of Maricopa Municipal Court (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to amend the Agreement to extend the term of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties specifically agree to amend the Agreement dated September 9, 2023 as follows:

- 1. Paragraph 3 is amended so the Agreement and this First Amendment shall remain in full force and effect until December 31, 2027, unless extended or terminated as otherwise provided pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Agreement and this First Amendment.
- 2. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement are to continue in full force and effect as if fully set forth herein.
