## TRANSPORTATION COMMENTS

The City of Maricopa requires that a Traffic Impact Analysis be completed if more than 100 peak hour trips are generated. If the development has less than 100 trips during peak hours a Traffic Impact Statement will suffice. This letter has been prepared to satisfy the City requirements for new development that generates less than 100 trips during peak hours. Staff has determined that the development will generate less than 100 peak hour trips and has referenced the ITE manuals. The proposed project is a fire station that will incorporate a meeting room that can be used by the community. This meeting room will function as a small recreational community center when not in use by the Fire Department. The ITE Trip Generation does not exist for a fire station. It is likely fire stations will generate relatively few trips, and depending on shift changes may not generate any trips during the peak hour. The fire station trip generation is assumed to be negligible. The table below illustrates the total projected traffic.
