Currently

- Multi-function printing is the most cost effective printing over single function units
- There are 16 multi-function printers/ copiers Citywide (3 are inoperable)
 - City Hall (11), PD (1), Fire locations (3) and Public Works (1)
- Approximately 1.2 million pages are produced each year (50% color, 50% black & white)
- Nine separate models utilized (three brands)



Currently

- Three separate warranty agreements
 - As of December 2011, one contract expired
- All units have exceeded their 5-year useful lives
- Significant down-time being experienced with 3 inoperable units
- FY11-12 cost of maintenance \$48,669
- Staff determined replacement is necessary due to end of useful life, down-time experienced & cost to continue



Objectives for Replacement

- Provide staff with functioning machines
- Standardize the make and operation of the units
- Determine the appropriate units based on the needs of each location before and after relocation to the new City Hall complex
- Evaluate the advantages of leasing versus buying the units



Objectives for Replacement (Continued)

- Provide multi-function units (ability to print, copy, scan and fax documents)
- Provide units with the ability to minimize color printing but still provides that capability if needed



Proposed Approach

- Provide three types of Konica Minolta multi-function machines + one plotter/scanner
 - Large color units (6)
 - Small color unit (4)
 - Small black & white unit (5)
 - Plotter Scanner (1)



Proposed Approach (Continued)

- Purchase (vs. lease)
 - Warranty is the same under either option
 - No budgetary impact for five years
 - Avoids \$20,316 in calculated interest over 5 years (assuming a five-year lease)



Cost

- Purchase \$114,042 (includes \$9,837 tradein)
- Maintenance
 - If nothing is done, it is assumed that the annual maintenance cost will at least continue to be at or in excess of the FY11-12 costs
