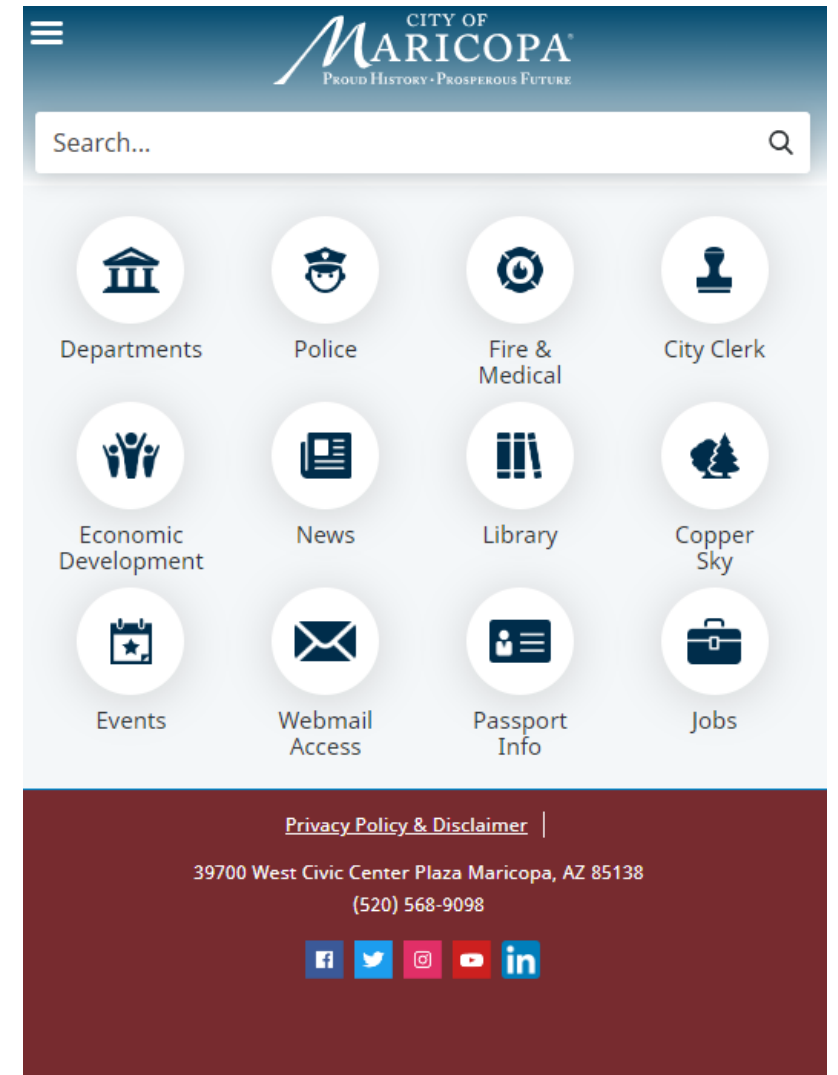
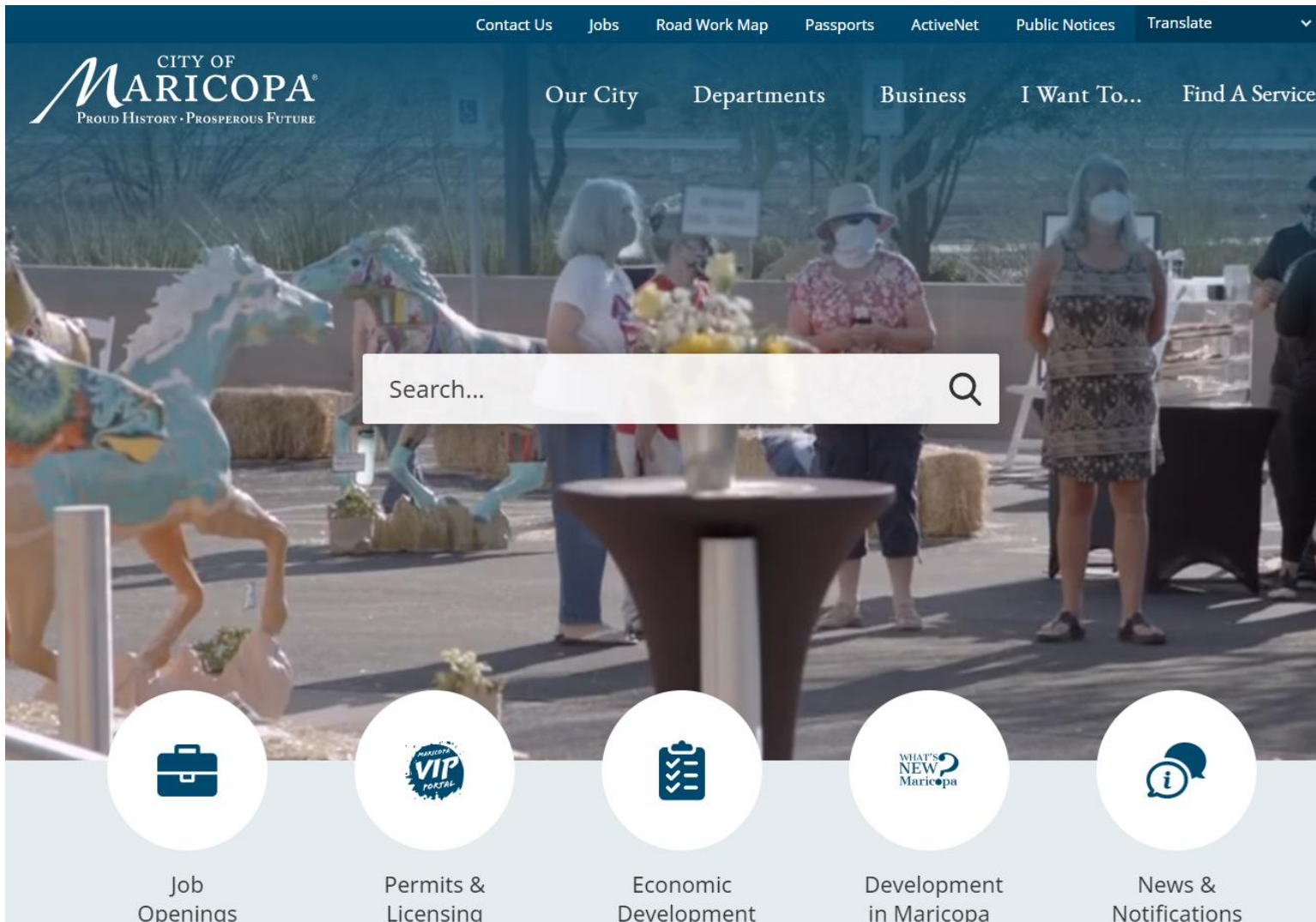

### Maricopa at a Glance

Maricopa offers residents and businesses the experience of a small-town atmosphere that is within a short distance to two major metropolitan areas.



- Maricopa is Arizona's 88th municipality, incorporated on October 15, 2003.
- The City's population is approximately 73,300. That is a 25% increase over 2020 Census numbers.
  - Median Age = 38.2
  - Residents with some college education or higher = 68.6%
  - Average Household Income = \$83,600
  - Median Home Value = \$356,300
- Maricopa is approximately 43 square miles, with a planning area of 233 square miles.

## Mayor & Council



The Maricopa City Council consists of a Mayor and six City Council members who each serve four-year terms. These positions are elected at large on a rotating basis, and are the only elected positions in the municipality. Elections are held in the fall of even numbered years on a rotating basis, so that all positions are up for election every two years. If a candidate obtains an absolute majority of votes for election in the primary, then he/she is not required to run in the general election.



### City of Maricopa Seeking Public Input on Proposed Pedestrian Safety Co


