

ORDINANCE NUMBER 19-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, AMENDING SECTION 2-82(3)(a) OF THE CITY CODE OF MARICOPA REGARDING COUNCIL STANDING SUBCOMMITTEES TO ELIMINATE THE MARKETING AND COMMUNICATIONS SUBCOMMITTEE, ELIMINATE THE PERSONNEL AND BENEFITS SUBCOMMITTEE, ELIMINATE THE LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS SUBCOMMITTEE AND REVISE THE BUDGET, FINANCE AND OPERATIONS SUBCOMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, have reviewed Section 2-82(3)(a) of the Code of the City of Maricopa concerning the standing council subcommittees; and

WHEREAS, after consultation with staff, the Mayor and Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, have determined that such section should be revised to eliminate the Marketing and Communication subcommittee, eliminate the Personnel and Benefits Subcommittee, eliminate the Legislative Affairs Subcommittee and revise the Budget, Finance and Operations Subcommittee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 2-82(3)(a) of the City Code of Maricopa, entitled Council Standing Subcommittees, and all amendments thereto are hereby repealed in its entirety and replaced with the following:

a) Established Standing Subcommittee:

- (i) A Budget & Finance Council Subcommittee shall convene from time to time as needed to conduct a review of the City's proposed budget and financial policies, and to provide City Council with feedback concerning the budget, compliance with policy and laws governing the budget process and to confirm consistency with Council's adopted Strategic Plan. The Budget & Finance Council Subcommittee will also be responsible for any projects specifically assigned to the subcommittee by City Council.

SECTION 2. To the extent of any conflict between other City Ordinances and this Ordinance, this Ordinance shall be deemed to be controlling; provided, however, that this Ordinance is not intended to amend or repeal any existing City Ordinance, Resolution or regulation except as expressly set forth herein.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become immediately effective thirty (30) days from the date of its passage and adoption by the City Council of the City of Maricopa.
