

RESOLUTION NO. 19-29

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND ADOPTING A UNIFORM VIDEO SERVICE LICENSE AGREEMENT AND APPLICATION TO COMPLY WITH ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES (ARS) TITLE 9, CHAPTER 13 RELATING TO UNIFORM REGULATION AND LICENSING OF VIDEO AND CABLE SERVICE PROVIDERS.

WHEREAS, in 2018, the State of Arizona approved Senate Bill 1140 (SB1140) which amended Title 9 of the Arizona Revised States by adding Chapter 13 relating to the uniform regulation and licensing of video and cable service providers; and

WHEREAS, SB1140 establishes the need for Uniform Video Service License Agreements, form, provisions and fees; and

WHEREAS, the City has adopted a model Uniform Video Service License Agreement that was developed by a working group of Arizona municipalities in cooperation with industry stakeholders and the League of Arizona Cities and Towns; and

WHEREAS, the Uniform Video Service License Agreement and Application sets forth the rights-of-way use requirements and authorizes the installation, operation and maintenance of video services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, hereby approves and adopts the Uniform Video Service License Agreement and Application in the form attached to and made a part of this Resolution.
