

RESOLUTION NO. 16-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, SETTING THE COMPENSATION FOR JUDGE PRO TEMPORES SERVING IN THE MARICOPA MUNICIPAL COURT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5-35 of the Maricopa City Code, the Maricopa City Council may appoint, upon recommendation of the Presiding Municipal Judge, a number of judges pro tempore necessary to fulfill the needs of the Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, on October 7, 2015, the City Council entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Pinal County for the co-location and operation of limited jurisdiction courts (the “IGA”); and

WHEREAS, several Judge Pro Tempores serve for both the Justice Court and the Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. §22-122(D), “[a] justice of the peace pro tempore is entitled to receive compensation as determined for an elected justice of the peace for the precinct where the justice of the peace pro tempore is assigned to serve”; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes during the term of the IGA, Judge Pro Tempores for the Municipal Court should be compensated the same as Judge Pro Tempores for the Justice Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona that, beginning January 1, 2016 and continuing throughout the term of the IGA, any Judge Pro Tempore appointed by the City Council to serve in the City of Maricopa Municipal Court shall be compensated at the same rate as provided for in A.R.S §22-122(D).
