Council Options:

Having completed the SNAP requirements, Mayor and Council may consider one of the following actions:

- Option 1: Take no action.
- Option 2: Consider a recommended name from the public outreach process:
 - o Herencia Lane
 - o Veterans Way
 - o Paradise Lane
- Option 3: Revert W. Cesar Chavez Lane to its previous street name, Arizona Avenue.
- Option 4: Choose another name.

Staff Recommendation:

- Staff recommends Mayor and Council approve **Resolution 26-09**, approving a street name change based on one of the recommended options for W. Cesar Chavez Lane in accordance with the City of Maricopa's, Street Naming and Addressing Procedures (SNAP).
