## **RESOLUTION NO. 25-21**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE AK-CHIN INDIAN COMMUNITY FOR MARICOPA SENIORS INC AND AGREEING TO ACT AS THE DESIGNATED FISCAL AGENT OF SUCH FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the Ak-Chin Indian Community disburses grant money to non-profit agencies within a broad spectrum of services and programs that serve the general public; and

**WHEREAS,** in order to be eligible to receive funding from the Ak-Chin Indian Community, a local non-profit must show that the City of Maricopa will act as a fiscal agent and accept funding on behalf on the non-profit 's behalf; and

WHEREAS, Maricopa Seniors Inc is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization that is dedicated to improving the quality of life for the City's aging population with a mission to provide programs that will create safe and healthy environments for seniors, a business base for seniors to receive discounted products and services, and provide an online resource directory; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council believe it would be beneficial for the citizens of the City of Maricopa and Pinal County to support the grant application of Maricopa Seniors Inc.

**NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY**, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, that the City of Maricopa, Arizona supports the submission of a grant application to the Ak-Chin Indian Community for funding Maricopa Seniors Inc and agrees to act as the designated fiscal agent for such funding.
