RESOLUTION NO. 15-39

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE AK-CHIN INDIAN COMMUNITY IN SUPPORT OF FUNDING THE F.O.R. MARICOPA FOOD BANK PROGRAM AND AGREEING TO ACT AS THE DESIGNATED FISCAL AGENT OF SUCH FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the Ak-Chin Indian Community disburses grant money to non-profit organizations that provide a broad spectrum of services and programs to the general public; and

WHEREAS, the application for such grant funding requires a local non-profit applicant to show the City of Maricopa will accept funding on behalf of the non-profit organization and agrees to act as the designated fiscal agent of such funding; and

WHEREAS, Food, Opportunity and Resources (F.O.R.) Maricopa is a 501(c)(3) organization that provides services for a food bank program serving residents within the City and its surrounding areas.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council believe it would be beneficial for the residents of the City of Maricopa and Pinal County to support the grant application of the F.O.R. Maricopa Food Bank; and,

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA that the City of Maricopa supports the submission of a grant application to the Ak-Chin Indian Community for funding the F.O.R. Maricopa food bank, authorizes the City of Maricopa to accept grant funding on behalf of F.O.R. Maricopa, and agrees to act as the designated fiscal agent of such funding.
