

RESOLUTION NO. 24-23

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA SUPPORTING THE
SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE AK
CHIN INDIAN COMMUNITY FOR THE BOYS & GIRLS
CLUBS OF THE SUN CORRIDOR AND AGREEING TO ACT
AS THE DESIGNATED FISCAL AGENT OF SUCH FUNDING.**

WHEREAS, the Ak Chin Indian Community disburses grant money to non-profit agencies within a broad spectrum of services and programs that serve the general public; and

WHEREAS, in order to be eligible to receive funding from the Ak Chin Indian Community, a local non-profit must show that the City of Maricopa will act as a fiscal agent and accept funding on behalf on the non-profit 's behalf; and

WHEREAS, the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sun Corridor is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization that supports academic success, good character and citizenship and healthy lifestyles; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council believe it would be beneficial for the citizens of the City of Maricopa and Pinal County to support the grant application of The Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sun Corridor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, that the City of Maricopa, Arizona supports the submission of a grant application to the Ak Chin Indian Community for funding the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sun Corridor and agrees to act as the designated fiscal agent for such funding.
