

RESOLUTION NO. 26-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE AK-CHIN INDIAN COMMUNITY FOR MARICOPA FRIENDS OF THE ARTS AND AGREEING TO ACT AS THE DESIGNATED FISCAL AGENT OF SUCH FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the Ak-Chin Indian Community disburses grant money to non-profit agencies within a broad spectrum of services and programs that serve the general public; and

WHEREAS, in order to be eligible to receive funding from the Ak-Chin Indian Community, a local non-profit must show that the City of Maricopa will act as a fiscal agent and accept funding on behalf on the non-profit 's behalf; and

WHEREAS, Maricopa Friends of the Arts is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that is dedicated to fostering, promoting, and financially supporting art forms in the City of Maricopa. Their mission is to be patrons of the arts by recognizing the benefits and joys art brings to individuals and communities. They aim to provide artistic experiences at meetings and events to further promote the arts and enrich lives through creative expression; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council believe it would be beneficial for the citizens of the City of Maricopa and Pinal County to support the grant application of the Maricopa Friends of the Arts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, that the City of Maricopa, Arizona supports the submission of a grant application to the Ak-Chin Indian Community for funding the Maricopa Friends of the Arts and agrees to act as the designated fiscal agent for such funding.
