However, members of the Council shall not discuss or take legal action on any matters during an open call to the public unless the matters are properly noticed for discussion and legal action.

An Ordinance of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, approving and adopting an amendment to the City's Zoning Map to zone certain property described in Zoning Case # ZON18-04 for approximately 9.21 acres of land generally situated at the southeast corner of the intersection of North John Wayne Pkwy (SR-347) and Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., within the City of Maricopa incorporated limits. The parcel of land is situated in a portion of the northwest quarter of Section 34 of Township 4 South, Range 3 east of the Gila and Salt River base and meridian, Pinal County, Arizona. Discussion and Action.

An Ordinance of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, approving and adopting an amendment to the City's Zoning Map to zone certain property described in Zoning Case # ZON18-02 for approximately 20 acres of land generally located south of the southeast corner of Bowlin Road and Hartman Road., within the City of Maricopa incorporated limits.
