7. Consent Agenda

The land is situated in a portion of Section 28 of Township 4 South, Range 3 east of the Gila and Salt River base and meridian, Pinal County, Arizona. Discussion and Action.

An Ordinance of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, approving and adopting an amendment to the City's Zoning Map to zone certain property descibed in Zoning Case #ZON 19-09 for approximately 16.95 acres of land generally located near the northwest corner of Bowlin Rd and John Wayne Pkwy (SR-347), within the City of Maricopa incorporated limits. The land is located in a portion of the southeast quarter of Section 28 of Township 4 South, Range 3 east of the Gila and Salt River base and meridian, Pinal County, Arizona. Discussion and Action.

8.4 PH 20-07

The Mayor and City Council shall hear public comment regarding the request by Duane Rudnick, to amend the designated land use for approximately 4 acres as identified in the General Plan Future Land Use Map (GPA19-04) and Zone Map Change (ZON19-10) for approximately 4 acres generally located on the north side of Farrell Road approximately one-half mile west of Porter Road, within the City of Maricopa incorporated limits.

8.5 RES 20-08

A Resolution of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, approving and adopting a minor General Plan land use amendment to change the land use from Medium Density Residential to Commercial for approximately 4 acres of land generally located west of Porter Road and north of Farrell Road, within the City of Maricopa incorporated limits, as described in Case # GPA 19-04. The land is situated in a portion of Section 35 of Township 4 South, Range 3 east of the Gila and Salt River base and meridian, Pinal County, Arizona. Discussion and Action.

8.6 ORD 20-02

An Ordinance of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, approving and adopting an amendment to the City's Zoning Map to zone certain property described in Zoning Case #ZON19-10 approximately 4 acres of land generally located west of Porter Rd and north of Farrell Raod, within the City of Maricopa incorporated limits. The land is located in a portion of Section 35 of Township 4 South, Range 3 east of the Gila and Salt River base and meridian, Pinal County, Arizona. Discussion and Action.

8.7 ORD 20-04

An Ordinance of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, approving and adopting an amendment to the City's Zoning Map to zone certain property described in Zoning Case # PAD20-03, for approximately 3.82 acres of land generally located at the southwest corner of N. Greythorn Dr. and N. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. within the City of Maricopa incorporated limits. The parcel of land is situated in a portion of Section 34 of Township 4 South, Range 3 East of the Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Pinal County, Arizona. Discussion and Action.
