6. Consent Agenda

- **6.1** <u>CON 20-07</u> The Mayor and City Council shall discuss and possibly take action to ratify a Purchase and Sale Agreement and Escrow Instructions with Sharon Holmes for the purchase the south half of the real property generally located at 44480 W. Maricopa-Casa Grande Highway for a purchase price of \$44,000.00. Discussion and Action.
- **6.2** <u>CON 20-08</u> The Mayor and City Council shall discuss and possibly to action to approve a Purchase and Sale Agreement and Escrow Instructions with Pinal County for the purchase of approximately 2.0 acres generally located at 46250 West McDavid Road for a purchase price of \$126,000.00 and authorize the City Manager to execute the Agreement and any necessary documents related thereto. 7.2 <u>MISC 20-09</u> If the Mayor and City Council determines that reasonable cause exists that Councilwoman Julia Gusse violated the Code of Ethics set forth in Chapter 2, Article VII of the Maricopa City Code under Agenda item 7.1, the Mayor and City Council shall then discuss and possibly take action on issuing sanctions against Councilwoman Julia Gusse for a violation of the Code of Ethics as set forth in Chapter 2, Article VII of the Maricopa City Code. Discussion and Action. Please note that no public comment will be received during this Agenda item.
