6. Call to the Public

The procedures to follow if you address the Council are: Council requests that you express your ideas in three minutes or less and refrain from any personal attacks or derogatory statements about any City employee, a fellow citizen, or anyone else, whether in the audience or not. The Mayor will limit discussion whenever he deems such an action appropriate to the proper conduct of the meeting. At the conclusion of an open call to the public, individual members of the Council may respond to criticism made by those who have addressed the Council, may ask Staff to review a matter, or may ask that a matter be put on a future agenda. However, members of the Council shall not discuss or take legal action on any matters during an open call to the public unless the matters are properly noticed for discussion and legal action.

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7. Consent Agenda

All items on the Consent Agenda are considered to be routine matters and will be enacted by one motion of the Council. There will be no separate discussion of these items unless a Councilmember or member of the public so requests, in which event the item will be removed from the Consent Agenda and considered in its normal sequence on the agenda.

- 7.1 <u>RES 21-08</u> A Resolution of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, approving and adopting the Second Amendment to the Development Agreement between the City of Maricopa and Property Reserve Arizona, LLC, an Arizona limited liability company in compliance with A.R.S. §9-500.05. Discussion and Action.
- 7.2 IGA 21-03 The Mayor and City Council shall discuss and possibly take action on approval of an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between the City of Maricopa and the State of Arizona for design and construction of pavement improvements on Anderson Road Maricopa/Casa Grande Highway to Peters and Nall Road, and Peters and Nall Road Anderson Road to Antone Street. This project is partially funded with Congestion Management Air Quality (CMAQ) funds with a total estimated project cost of \$641,014, which includes \$604,476 in federal funds and a 5.7% local match of \$36,538. Funding for the local match will be drawn from Transportation DIF 2-Public Works, Street Projects-Capital, CMAQ Paving Anderson and Peters Nall (34655151-67750-40036) and Transportation DIF 2-Public Works, Design Services-Street Projects, CMAQ Paving Anderson and Peters Nall (34655151-67755-40036). Discussion and Action.
- 7.3 <u>SUB 21-04</u> The Mayor and City Council shall discuss and possibly take action to approve a final plat for the "Estrella Gin" light industrial/office development, case #SUB21-04. Discussion and Action.
