#### 7. Consent Agenda

- 7.1 CON 21-29 The Mayor and City Council shall discuss and take action to approve a Purchase and Sale Agreement and Escrow Instructions with Tibirin, LLC, and Arizona limited liability company for the sale of approximately .52 acres of real property generally located north of W Bowlin Rd and east of N White and Parker Rd for \$67,953.60 and authorizing the city manager to execute any necessary extensions and closing documents related thereto. Discussion and Action.
- 7.2 ORD 21-23 An Ordinance of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, approving and adopting an amendment to the City's Zoning Map to rezone approximately 330 acres of land generally located at the northeast corner of W. Maricopa-Casa Grande Highway and N. Hartman Road within the City of Maricopa incorporated limits, from Single Family Residential (CR-3), General Rural (GR) and General Commercial (CB-2) to Planned Area Development (PAD) as described in Case #PAD 21-07.
