The procedures to follow if you address the Council are: Council requests that you express your ideas in three minutes or less and refrain from any personal attacks or derogatory statements about any City employee, a fellow citizen, or anyone else, whether in the audience or not. The Mayor will limit discussion whenever he deems such an action appropriate to the proper conduct of the meeting. At the conclusion of an open call to the public, individual members of the Council may respond to criticism made by those who have addressed the Council, may ask Staff to review a matter, or may ask that a matter be put on a future agenda. However, members of the Council shall not discuss or take legal action on any matters during an open call to the public unless the matters are properly noticed for discussion and legal action.

8.2 PH 22-04

The Mayor and City Council shall hear public comment regarding a Minor General Plan Amendment requested by the City of Maricopa on behalf of Iplan Consulting to amend the General Plan Future Land Use Map (GPA22-03) for approximately 111 acres from existing Low Density Residential (LDR) to Master Planned Community (MPC), generally located at the northwest corner of the W. Ruben Dr. and N. Ensenada Rd. road alignments, or approximately 0.5 miles west of N. Anderson Rd. and 0.65 miles north of W. Teel Rd.

8.3 RES 22-21

A Resolution of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, approving and adopting a Minor General Plan Land Use Amendment to change the land use from Low Density Residential (LDR) to Master Planned Community (MPC) on approximately 111 acres generally located at the northwest corner of the road alignments of W. Ruben Drive and N. Ensenada Road as requested by the City of Maricopa on behalf of Iplan Consulting in case #GPA 22-03. Discussion and Action.
