A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE AK CHIN INDIAN COMMUNITY FOR THE BOYS & GIRLS CLUB OF THE SUN CORRIDOR AND AGREEING TO ACT AS THE DESIGNATED FISCAL AGENT OF SUCH FUNDING.
